

## Cookie Policy

### a. Why we use cookies and how we do it

We use cookies on our website [www.kronospanfoundation.org](http://www.kronospanfoundation.org) (hereinafter “the Site”) in order to distinguish between you and other Site users. This helps us improve your experience when you visit our Site and, in addition, we use cookies in order to make sure that the Site works as you expect it.

By further browsing the Site, you agree that we use cookies. You have the possibility to disable/delete cookies by changing the settings of your device/browser. Kronospan Foundation is liable neither for cookies placed on your devices by other websites, nor for data collected with the help of such cookies.

The purpose of this cookie policy is to provide you with clear and detailed information about the cookies we use and their purpose. ### b. What are cookies

Cookies are small text files placed on your computer, smartphone or other device by the website you visit. These are used on a large scale in order to ensure the website's operability or to make sure that the website works more efficiently, as well as in order to provide services and browsing features. Cookies are useful because they allow the Site to recognise the user's device. Cookies may be “permanent” or “session cookies”. Permanent cookies are made up of a text file that is sent by a server to a browser and is stored by that browser and remains active until its expiry date (if it is not deleted before by the user). The “session cookies” expire at the end of the user's browsing session, when the internet browser is closed.

### c. Cookies on the Site

We use the following types of cookies:

- “Analytical” cookies, which are used in order to improve the Site for those who visit it regularly. These cookies help us see what the visitors like or don't like and how we can improve their experience on the Site.
- “Strictly necessary” cookies, which are essential for the proper operation of the Site. Among them are cookies which allow the visitors to login to safe areas of the Site.

The table below lists the cookies on the Site and the reason why we use them

**e. Cookies and personal data**

We shall not send to third parties no personal data collected from you by means of the cookies on the Site.

**g. How you can manage the cookies**

If you wish to configure your preferences concerning the cookies used by the Site or any other website, you can do it by changing the browser's settings. The "Help" tool available in any browser will guide you in setting the options.

Nevertheless, please remember that very often cookies are used to facilitate and improve certain features of the Site. If you decide to disable certain cookies, it is possible that the Site performance is affected and you cannot access parts of it.
